Study Guide Group Questions: 1 Thessalonians 3 & 4

3) In Ch. 4 verse 11, Paul tells the Thessalonians that they should mind their own business. Offer some examples as to what actions Paul is trying to get them to avoid.

4) Between the living and those who have fallen asleep, what will be the order of the rapture when Christ comes for His church?

5) Will Christ come to earth when He returns to gather His church to himself?

6) What is the meaning of the phrase "caught up" in chapter 4 verse 17?

7) At the time of the church being "caught up" to be with Christ, is this what the Bible teaches as Christ's second coming?
