Study Guide Group Questions: Revelation Ch. 15 & 16

- 1) As the first angel in Revelation 16 pours out the first bowl of God's wrath, where have we seen this kind of plague (festering sores) before in the Bible?
- 2) What are some similarities and differences between the second bowl judgement in Revelation 16:3 and the second trumpet judgement in Revelation 8?

- 3) In Revelation 16 verses 3-6, we see "blood" being mentioned several times. Where else have seen blood appear in God's wrath and what is the meaning behind it?
- 4) Read carefully what Revelation 16:12 is saying. How does it relate to the sixth angel in Revelation 9? Are they the same angel?
- 5) How would you explain the meaning behind Christ's words in Revelation 16:15?

- 6) After rereading Revelation 8 & 9, describe the relationship you see between these two chapters and Revelation 16.
- 7) In Revelation 16:17, we hear a loud voice speak the words, "It is done!" Where have we heard these similar words? And what does this phrase mean?
