Study Guide Group Questions: Revelation Ch. 3 & 4

1) Do you notice anything different about the Church in Sardis as compared to the first four churches? Think of the pattern that Christ uses in these letters and see if you can tell what's missing with this one.

2) Which of these last three churches in chapter 3 did Christ find no fault?

3) Where does the "open door" lead that Christ mentions to the Church of Philadelphia in verse 8?

4) What specific event is Christ referring to in chapter 3 verse 10?

5) What is the meaning of the symbolism Christ uses in verse chapter 3 verse 18, "I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich?"

6) What are the incentives that Christ offers these last three churches in order for them to repent and heed his warning about their faults and falling away from sound doctrine?
